# Hide-and-Seek Critterscaping

We are pleased to have been awarded a grant from NatureKids for this stewardship project and doubly pleased that our long-time, favourite nature mentor, Gord Gadsden, has matched our grant and found the perfect location for our stewardship planting.

He will have the site prepped and ready for us to plant – ours is the fun part! Our role will be to dig the holes and plant the carefully chosen variety of native plants which are best suited to our site, then cover the area with cardboard and mulch.



## IMPORTANT NOTES:

- This is a rain or shine Explorer Day, so please dress for the weather. Layers allow the freedom to add or remove as needed, and a raincoat and hat are essential if it is raining. It may be mucky, so gum boots are a good option.
- **Bring a shovel if you have one.**
- Cheam Lake Wetlands is gorgeous! There are picnic tables and washrooms on site, and lovely hiking trails if you feel like a ramble after planting.
- Bring binoculars if you are interested in birds – this is Gord's specialty.
- We will have a bucket and net for pond dipping.
